

Fawn Tall Fescue

A cool- season bunch grass with a 4- 5 foot long root system, which provides better heat and drought tolerance than other cool- season grasses. Makes its best growth in fertile soils and will tolerate moist bottom lands. Palatability is best when plants are young, as stems and leaves become coarse with age. Other cool seasons may be better suited for forage purposes. It is also a perennial.

It is recommended that it should be planted at a rate of 8 to 12 lbs per acre.
