Together, they control a wide range of lawn weeds including dandelion, chickweed, knotweed, plantains, herb, spurge and many others found in home lawns. Established turf of Kentucky bluegrass, bentgrass, bahiagrass, centipedegrass, fescue, bermudagrass, zoysiagrass, and perennial ryegrass may be treated.

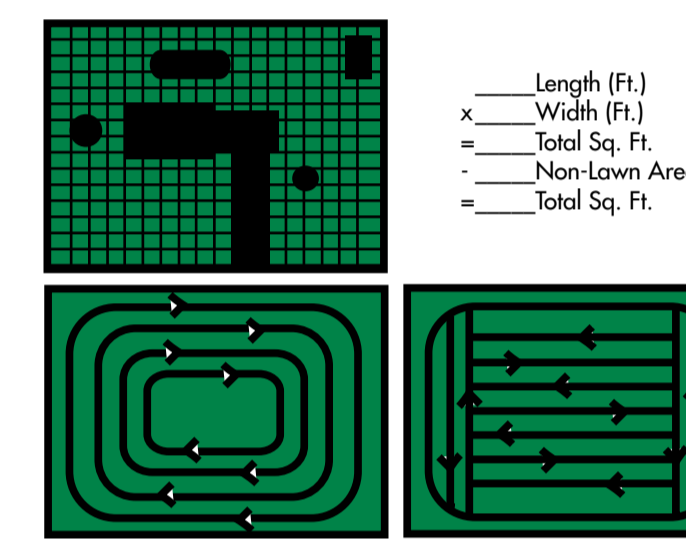

SPREADING SUGGESTIONS

It is important to follow the directions as indicated on this quality lawn care product as over-application may cause injury to your lawn. Measure the size of area to be treated and do not over or under apply. Spreader settings are approximate. Differences may occur due to condition of spreader, speed at which applied and roughness of area treated. Calibrate spreader prior to use according to manufacturer's directions. Check frequently to be sure equipment is working properly and distributing uniformly. Close spreader when filling, stopping, or turning. Do not apply by hand or with a hand-held spreader.

BROADCAST SPREADERS: For best results, apply in a circular path starting on the outside and working toward the center (see Path A below). A little overlap of product will ensure complete coverage.

DROP SPREADERS: First apply 2 border strips along the edge of each end of the lawn (see Path B below). Then apply product along the length of the lawn, overlapping slightly and shutting off the spreader before turning as you reach the edge of the border strips.
